## Around Alconbury Weald

### Community engagement: Phase 4

We are consulting on the framework plans for Phase 4, which will include new homes and connecting roads, paths and cycle ways, as well as additional play areas and pocket parks. It could also include shops and offices coming forward around a future rail station.

### Prestley Country Park

We are continuing to work up plans for the Country Park with Nene Park Trust. This will lead to a planning application for planting and amenities in the northern section of the park, alongside a more natural regenerative farming process in the southern area that will result in nature rich grassland and meadow over a number of years. Some of this approach, including grazing sheep, is being progressed to start later this spring.

We'll provide an update in the next *Warbler*. In the meantime, keep an eye on signage, the Alconbury Weald website and social media for more information as the plans develop.

### Double yellow lines outside primary school

Following concerns from both parents and residents regarding unsafe and inconsiderate parking outside Ermine Street Church Academy, Urban&Civic has been working with Cambridgeshire County Council to agree an approach to installing double yellow lines ahead of the road being formally adopted by them.

The introduction of double yellow lines will help improve safety around the school. Until the road is adopted, the parking enforcement officer will continue to carry out patrols as usual.

If you have recently moved to Alconbury Weald, please register as soon as possible so the Practice has all the information needed to provide you with the appropriate care when required.

If you are aged 40 to 74, and you don't have a pre-existing condition (such as diabetes), you are eligible for an NHS Health Check once every five years. These are available at Saturday clinics. Please contact reception to find out more.
